Agenda for International Overdose Awareness Event

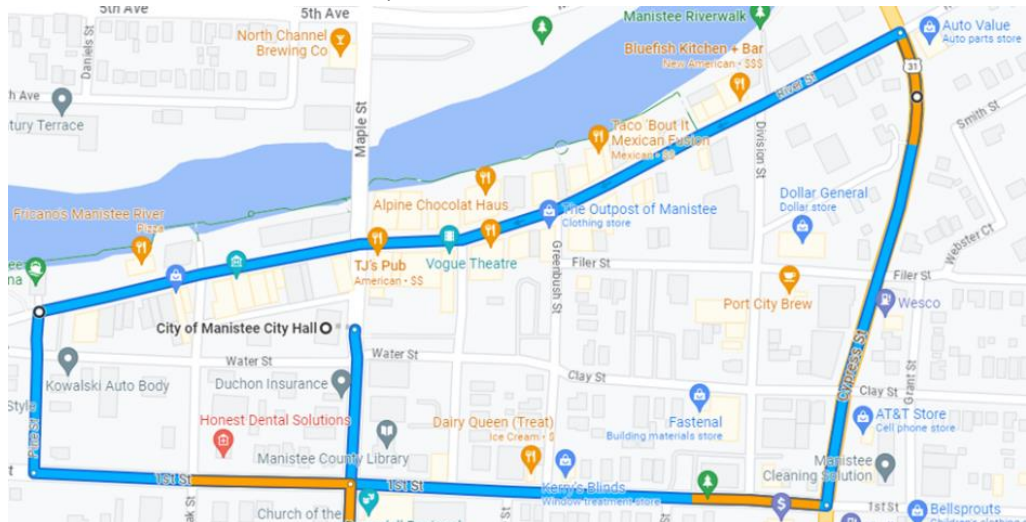
Location: Manistee Municipal Marina,
